**Requested Information:**

1. How many safeguarding investigations are done yearly?
2. What is the average number of safeguarding investigations per nurse?
3. What is the ratio of safeguarding males to females ie. What sex is being investigated?
4. How many safeguarding investigations has Mrs. Lucy Wright from CFT instigated?
5. What is the ratio of safeguarding of the investigated males to females for Mrs. Lucy Wright from CFT?

**Response:**

1. The Royal Cornwall Hospitals Trust's (RCHT) data is integrated with Cornwall Partnership Foundation Trust's (CFT). It covers children, adults and maternity. Due to these points, it would not be possible to provide an accurate figure for RCHT alone.
2. The Trust's safeguarding practitioners are not all nurses. It is therefore not possible to provide an accurate figure in this format.
3. As stated in response to question 1, RCHT's data is integrated with CFT's. It is therefore not possible to provide an accurate figure to this question.
4. RCHT cannot comment on or provide information regarding members of staff from other Trusts.
5. RCHT cannot comment on or provide information regarding members of from other Trusts.
